San Luis Coastal Unified School District will be offering a summer school program under the supervision of the Adult School.

Classes for students currently in Grades K-5 will be held at 3 summer school sites: C.L. Smith - San Luis Obispo, Del Mar – Morro Bay, Monarch Grove – Los Osos. Classes begin Monday, June 23 and end Thursday, July 24 (Monday – Thursday only). Class time is 8:15 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. with teacher duty day time 7:45 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.

Summer school provides academic intervention for students presently in grades K -5 who are in danger of retention or who need additional instruction in math, reading/language arts, or English language acquisition. Special Education classes are offered to identified students. Summer school also offers enrichment classes in language arts, fine arts, science, social science and mathematics.

Classes for students currently in Grades 6 -12 will be held at 2 summer school sites: Laguna Middle School, San Luis Obispo and Los Osos Middle School, Los Osos. Secondary Summer School will be divided into two sessions. Session I will begin Monday, June 23 and extend through Tuesday, July 15. Session II will begin Wednesday, July 16 and conclude Thursday, August 7. Students have the option of participating in either or both sessions. Classes will be offered Mondays through Thursdays. Class time is 8:00 a.m. to 12:55 p.m. with teacher duty day time 7:45 a.m. - 1:15 p.m.

Classes for students currently in grades 6-7 will include: Language Arts/Reading Skills, Math Plus, Pre-Algebra, English for English Language Learners and Special Education.

Classes for students currently in Grades 8-12 will include:

The teacher hourly rate of pay for summer school is \$29.08/hour.

The application form is printed on the back of this letter. Please return completed applications to the Personnel Office by 4:00 p.m., Friday, March 14, 2008 for Elementary. The Secondary application deadline will remain open until all positions are filled.

All applications will be screened on the basis of job-related criteria. Preference will be given to current San Luis Coastal teachers. Applicants deemed to be most qualified will be contacted by telephone and scheduled for an interview. After selections have been made, all interviewees will be notified.

In the event that State funding is reduced or discontinued, Summer School may be cancelled, in which case students, parents and staff will be notified as soon as possible. Low student enrollment and/or low attendance could result in the cancellation of a class and the dismissal of a teacher.

Paid Administrative Fieldwork positions are available for teachers who are concurrently working on an Administrative Credential through an accredited institution. Preference will be given to in-district employees who are seeking an administrative path in their career.
