SITE: MBHS

KEEP DOING:

- Supporting students (only 3% of students said they don't feel supported at MBHS, only 8% think bullying is an issue at MBHS)
- Utilizing Technology (only 5% of students wanted to prioritize more tech, 57% feel it enhances their learning)
- Being approachable (88% of students are comfortable or neutral approaching administrators, 93% of students feel their teachers are willing to support them or neutral)
- Supporting Extracurriculars and Programs (80% of students are involved in extra programs)

IMPROVEMENT AREAS:

- Physical appearance (short term and long term)
- Bring more Measure D awareness (only 21.7% of students feel informed)
- Prepare students better for life after HS (only 27% agree they are prepared for life after HS and 43.4% neutral)

TOP PRIORITIES FOR 2017-2018:

- Physical Appearance of campus (36.8% of students wanted to prioritize appearance of campus and 27.6% don't take pride in the appearance of our campus)
- Incorporating more spirit raising events on campus (24% of students want to prioritize more spirit raising events next year)
