Teen-1: June 18 – June 22

GRAPHIC NOVEL FIGURE ILLUSTRATION *with teaching artist Guy Kinnear*

Use professional illustrating techniques—figurative anatomy, expressive stylization, body language, and facial character development—to draw unique human personalities that tell your stories.

Teen-2: June 25 – June 29

WEAVING LAB *with teaching artist Kathy Friend*

Hands on! Learn how to weave using yarns, fleece and found objects into wearable art. Weave your own long belt, flowing scarf, or wall-hanging. Find out about Inkle looms and rigid heddles! Have fun using low-tech tools in a hi-tech world.

Teen-3: July 9 – July 13

ART IN THE ROUND *with teaching artist Barbara Rosenthal*

Start by painting mandalas and free-flowing compositions on unusual 2d circular surfaces. Keep the sun shining with a 3d umbrella as your substrate. Learn to use acrylic paints in lots of different ways; skills to last a lifetime.

Teen-4: July 16– July 20

BRUSHSTROKES IN SUMI-E *with teaching artist Guy Kinnear*

Work with bamboo brushes to explore the basics of *sumi-e*, the art of Japanese black ink paintings. Discover the thousand marks hidden in a single brush. We will explore the visual poetry of the simplest blade of grass to fire breathing dragons!

Teen-5: July 23 – July 27

COLLAGE, PHOTO MONTAGE & ASSEMBLAGE *with teaching artist Carolyn Balogh*

Explore artists such as Romare Bearden, Louise Nevelson and contemporary photo montage artists. Experience how repeating a variety of images, shapes, colors and materials can create unity and make a bold, modern artistic statement.

Teen-6: July 30 – August 3

CREATING IN CLAY *with teaching artist Marti Niles*

Shape your own clay sculptures from bobble head figures to symbolic animals for your own totem. Expand your creativity in clay building with a variety of different size projects. After firing, your clay pieces can be painted or decorated. You'll want to dress for messy art making!
